SAT (for Year 11 and 12 students)

This year's next SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) will take place on Saturday, the 23rd of August. The British School of Costa Rica will serve as a test center on this date. The registration deadline is Friday, August 8th. The test fee is \$111, payable online. For more information on 2025 test dates and deadlines, please visit the International SAT Dates. Most Year 11 NB and Year 12 students registered for the Instituto Tecnológico de Costa Rica (TEC) admissions exam will have it on the same date and time as this SAT. Please check for a scheduling conflict, and if there is one, register for a different SAT date.

BSCR NEWS - Secondary

The SAT is a standardized test administered by The College Board. Many universities worldwide, particularly in the United States, consider it either a requirement or an optional part of the application process. The SAT is now digital, and students are allowed to use their own computers or tablets. For practice and preparation resources, please visit the SAT Practice and Preparation Information. Khan Academy is an excellent free resource for SAT preparation.
